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## Republicans Carry Fleming County Election Results Are Official

Election 2022 has come and gone and the official results are in. 5,202 citizens went to poles to cast their votes for their favorite candidates. Voter turnout in Fleming county was 47%.

In the sheriffs race Republican Tim Smith defeated incumbent Gary Kinder (D) by a narrow margin, Smith 2742 and Kinder 2380 votes.

Incumbent Robert F. Money retained his position as Mayor of Flemingsburg receiving 451 with opponents Van Doodle Alexander receiving 302 votes and Mondre Saunders with 97 votes.
