Public Awareness Program

The City of Flemingsburg Natural Gas System would like to announce their Public Awareness Program. This pertains to all customers, non customers, residential and businesses in the Flemingsburg Natural Gas System area. It is important for everyone to understand the characteristics of natural gas. Natural gas is colorless and odorless in its raw state. An odorant is added to natural gas to give it an easily detectable smell. Natural gas then smells like sulfur or commonly known as rotten eggs. If you smell this odor or suspect a leak exit the area immediately, if indoors exit the building immediately. Do not operate any electrical light switches, garage door openers or telephones. Once outside at a safe distance where you can no longer smell natural gas use a neighbor's telephone or a cell phone to call 911 and they will call the proper authorities. Always call 911 before you dig.

The Panther Players of the Week are the Fleming County varsity cheerleaders. Last Saturday, the Panther Cheer squad turned in a fantastic performance at the KHSAA Regionals in Belfry. The Cheer team came up just short of qualifying for the KHSAA State Championship next month, but they will continue their fantastic season performing at basketball and other events



The Panther football team had their four-game winning streak and 2022 season come to an end last Friday in a second round loss at fifth-ranked Bell County. Fleming County finished the season 7-5 and will say goodbye to nine seniors, but return several key underclassmen in 2023. Heading the list of players for next year will be Austin Trent, who rushed for 1788 yards and 19 touchdowns this season, while gaining more than 100 yards in eight games.
